 - Traumatic Brain Injury Beds (Certified)

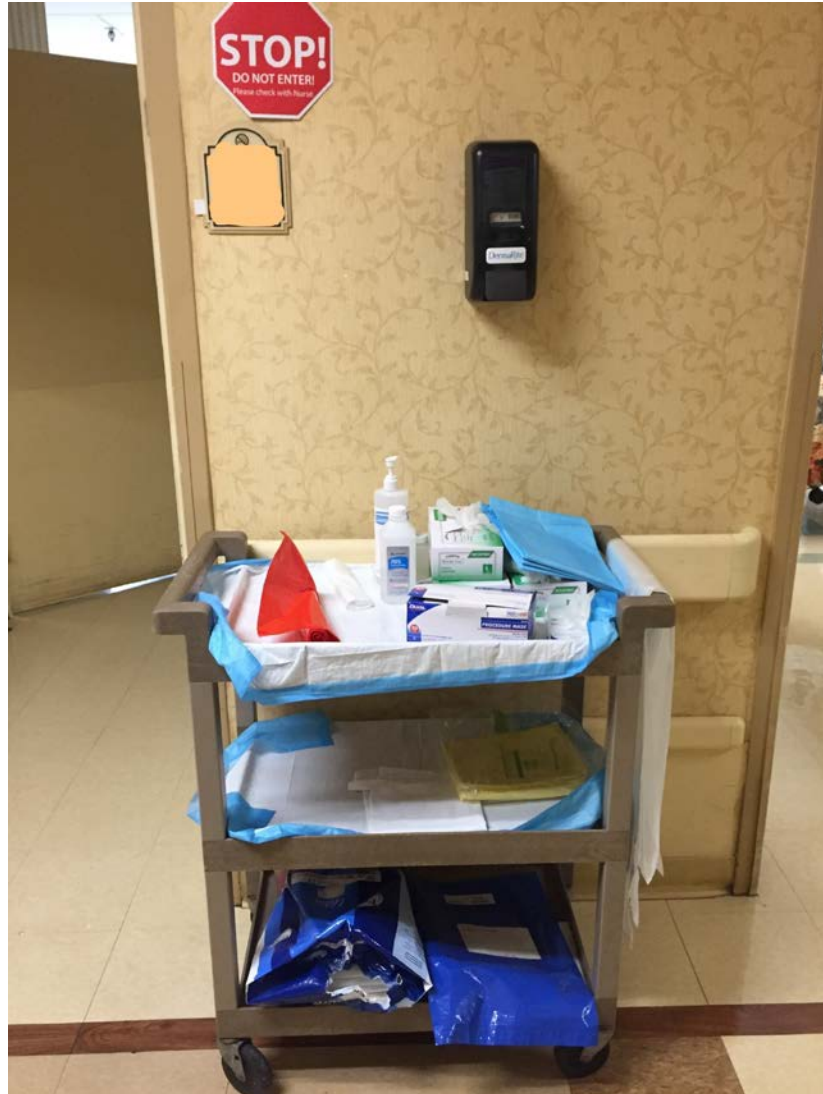

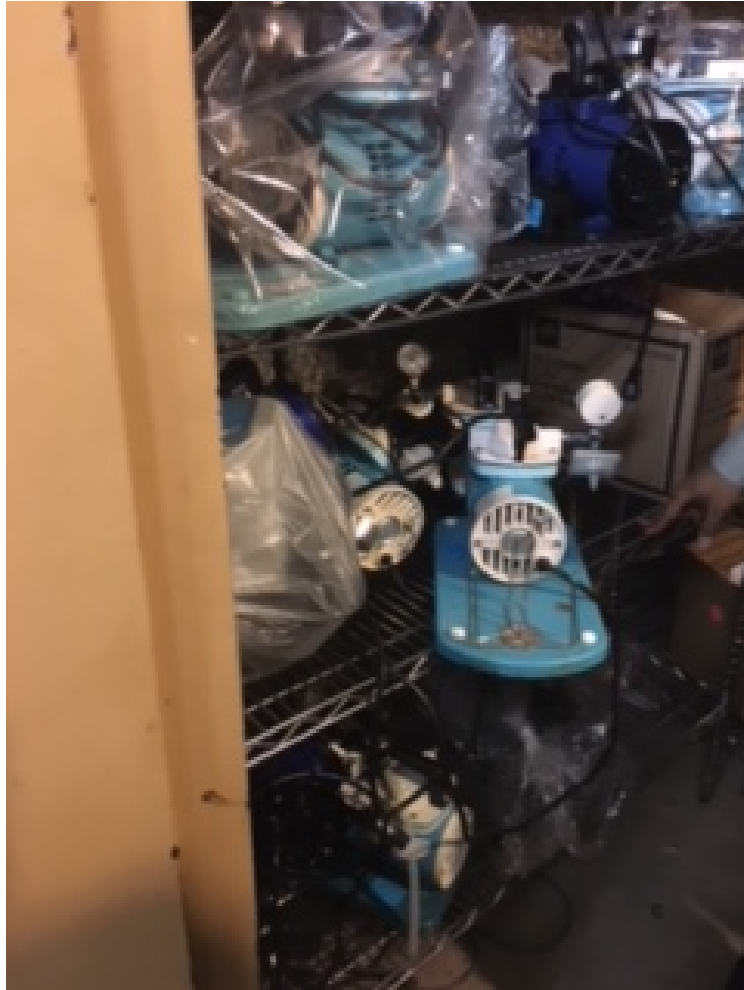
