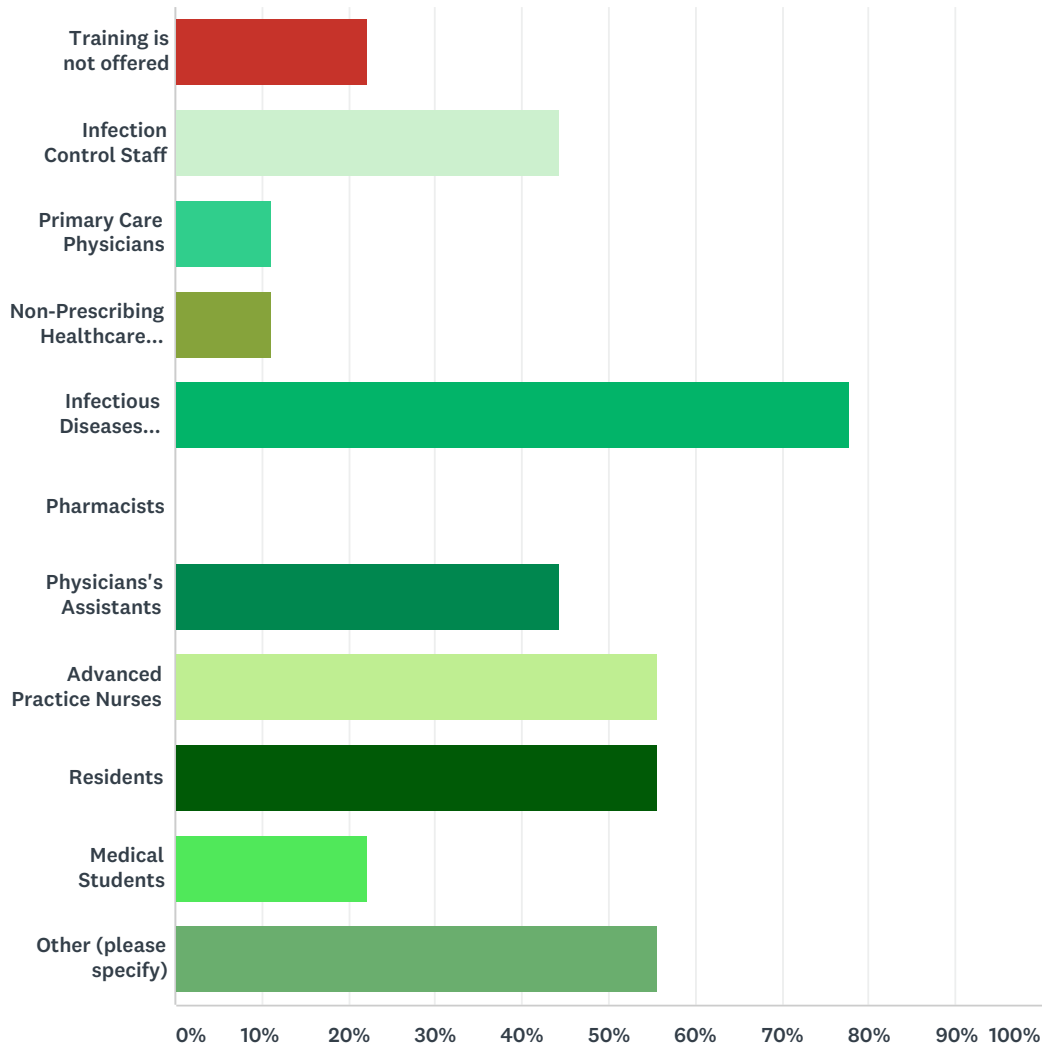

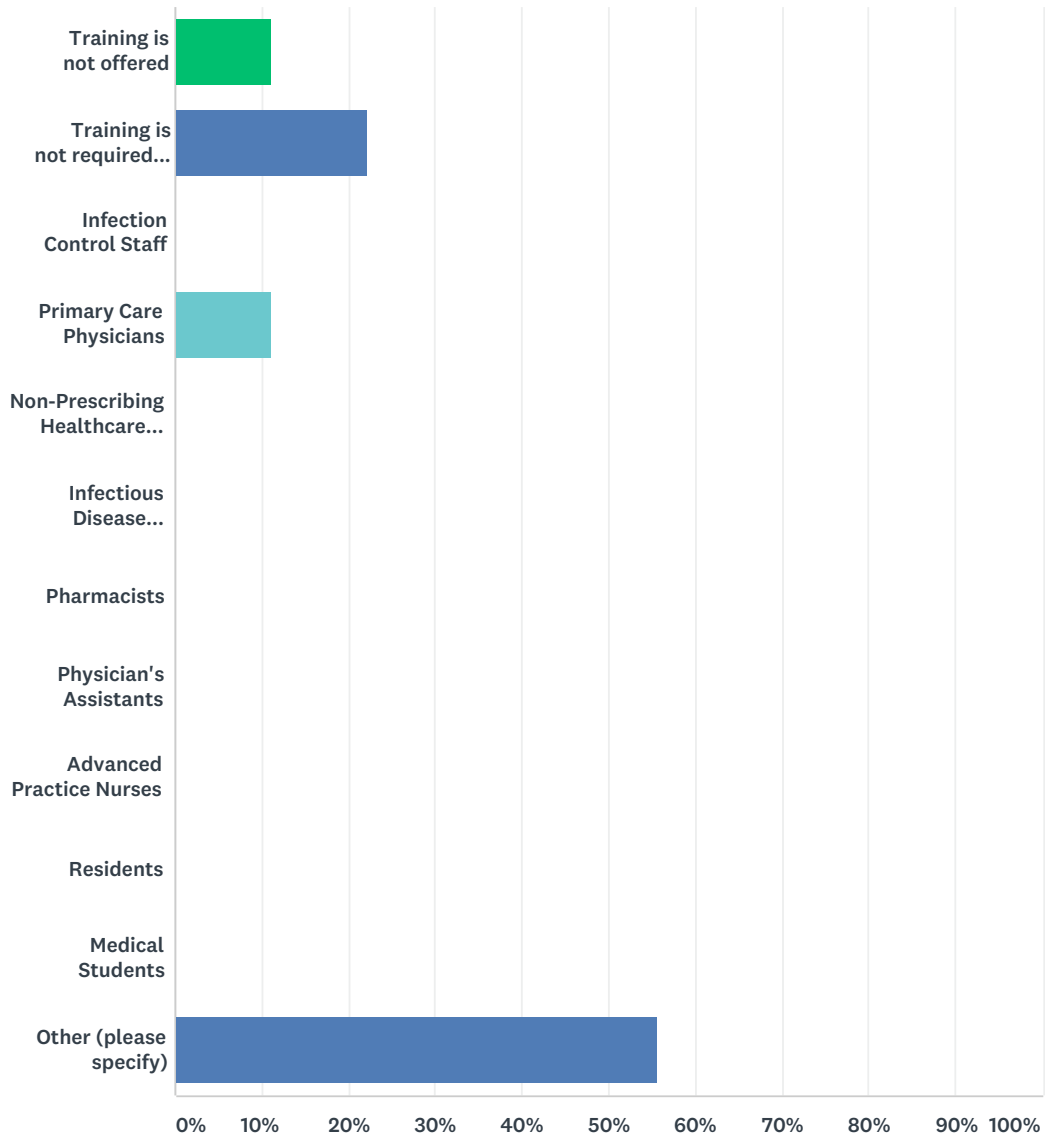

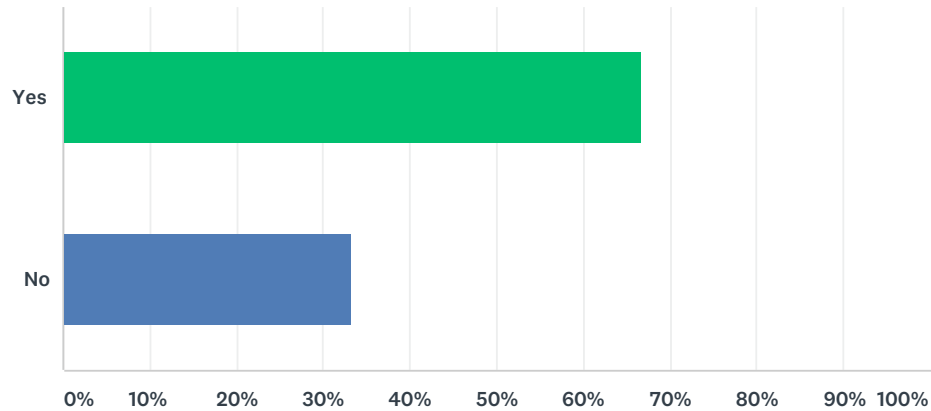

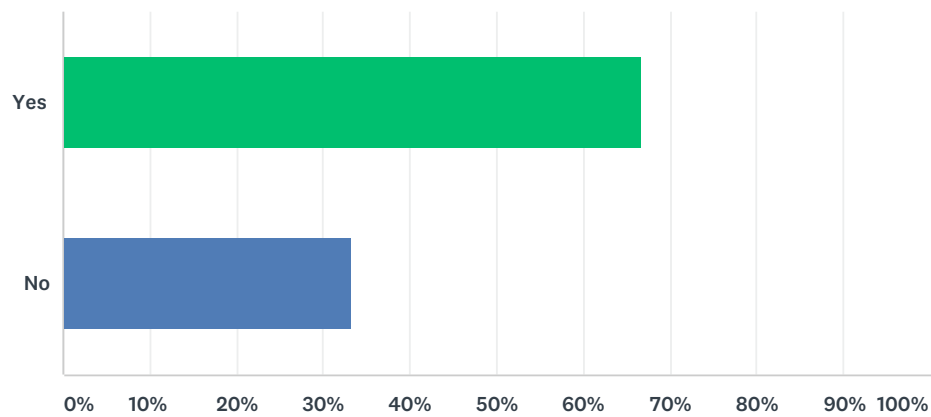

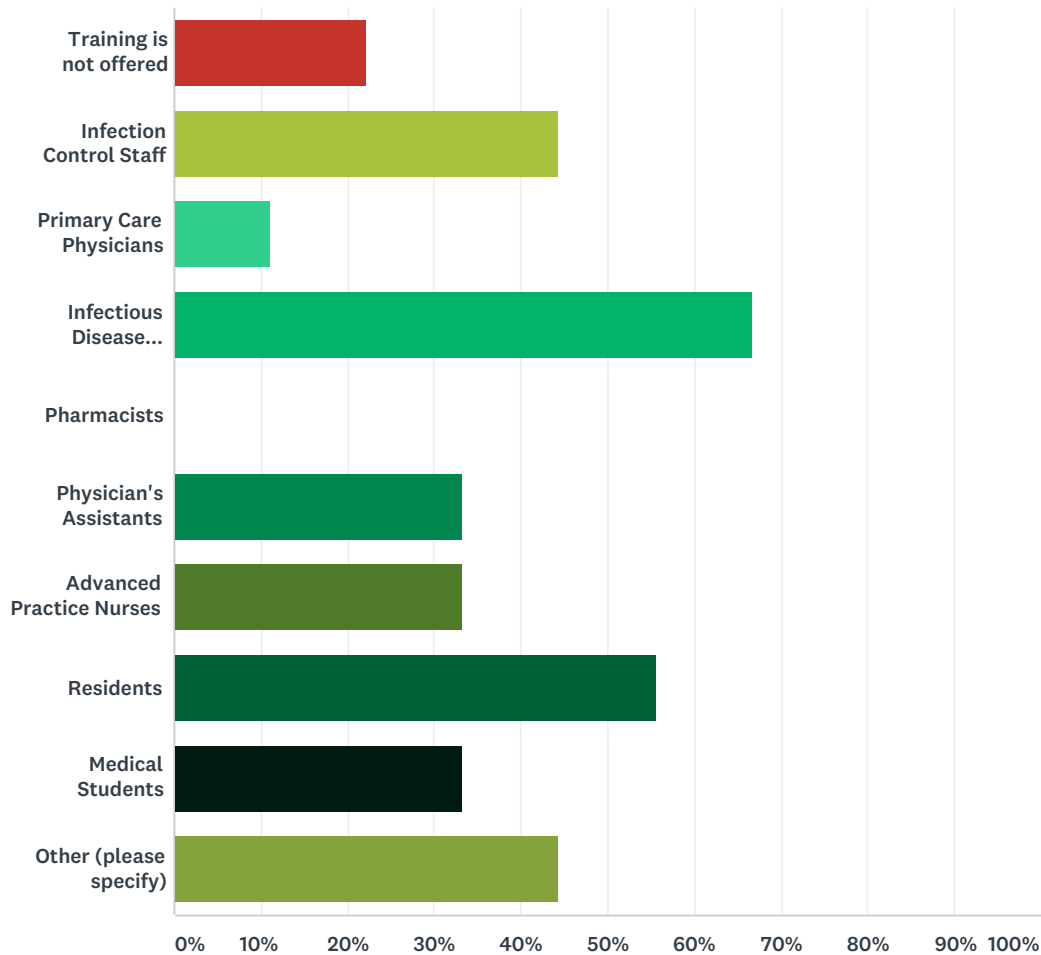

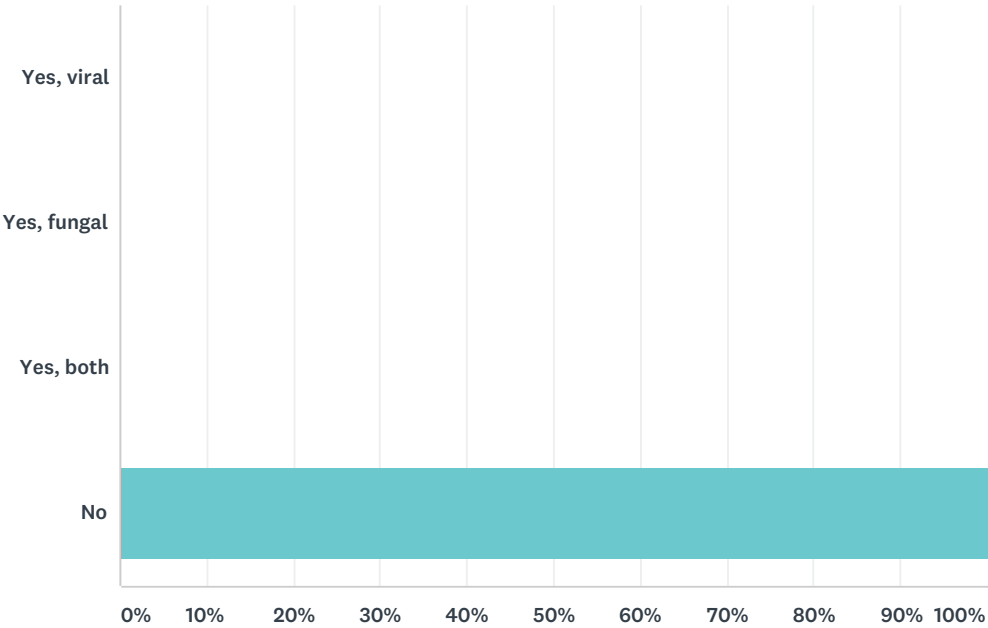

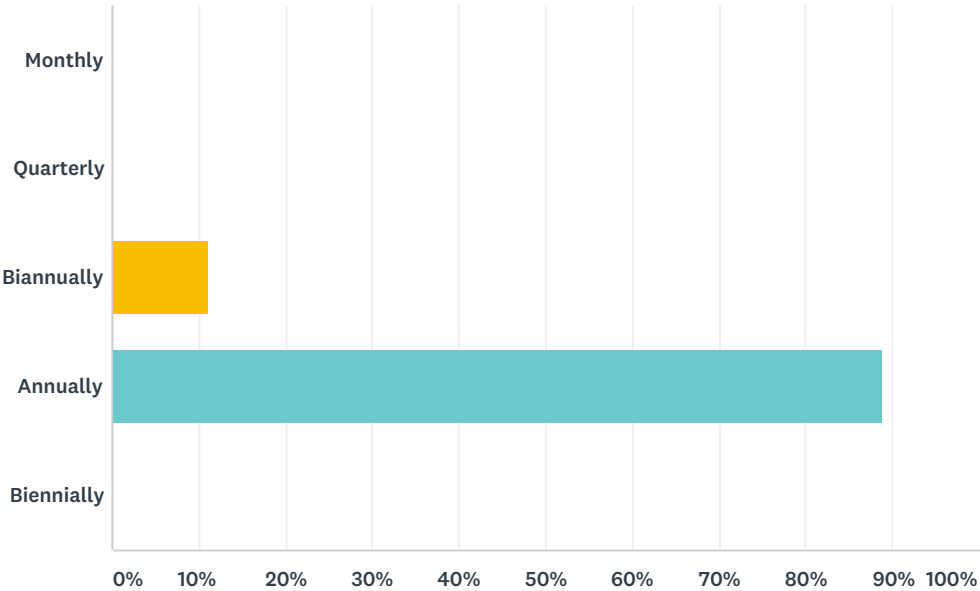

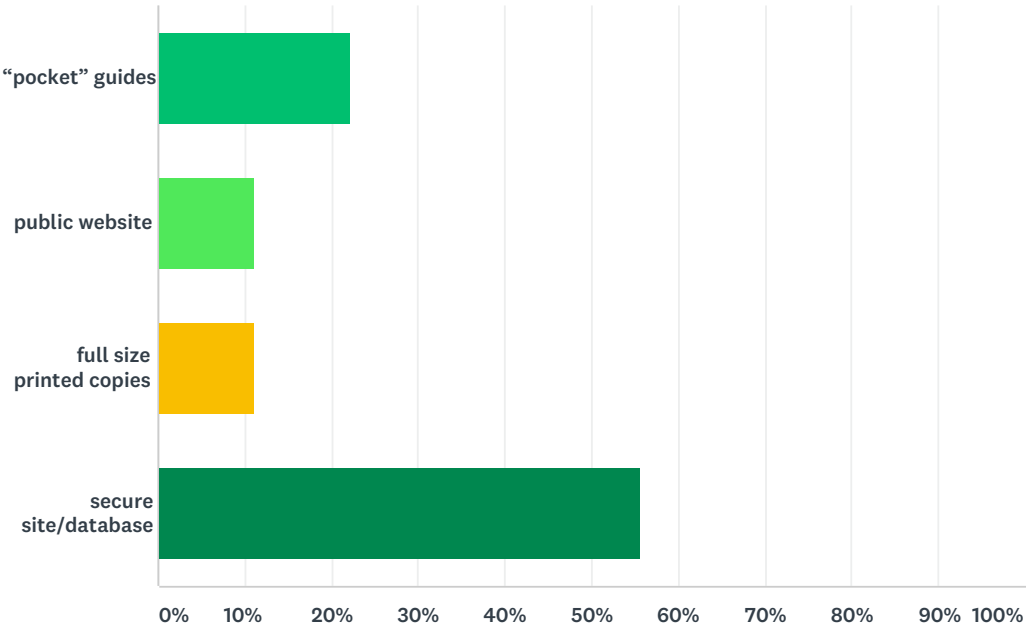

Q15 How is the antibiogram primarily distributed?

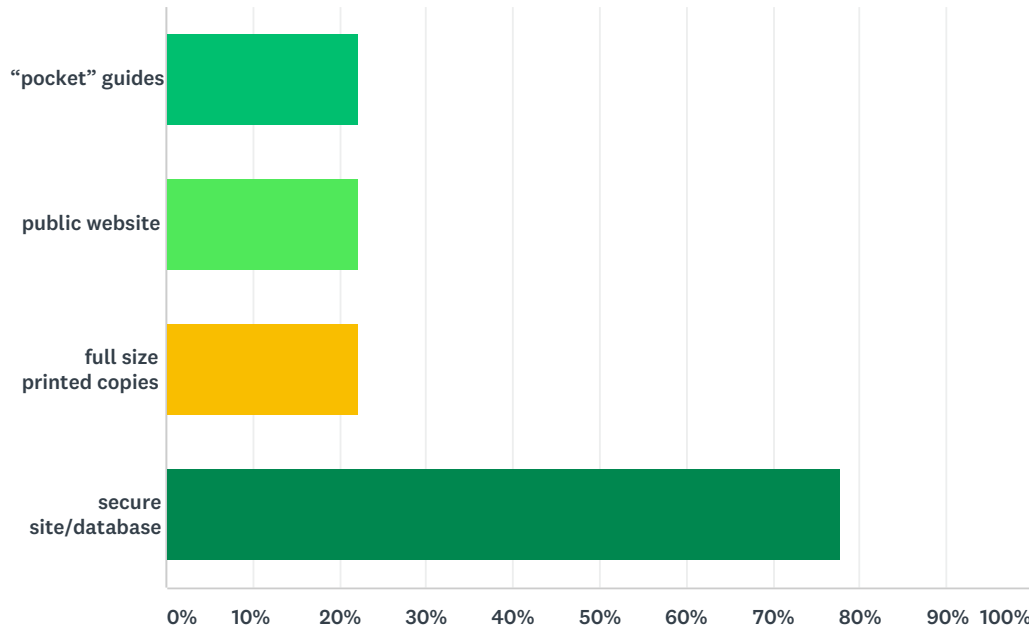

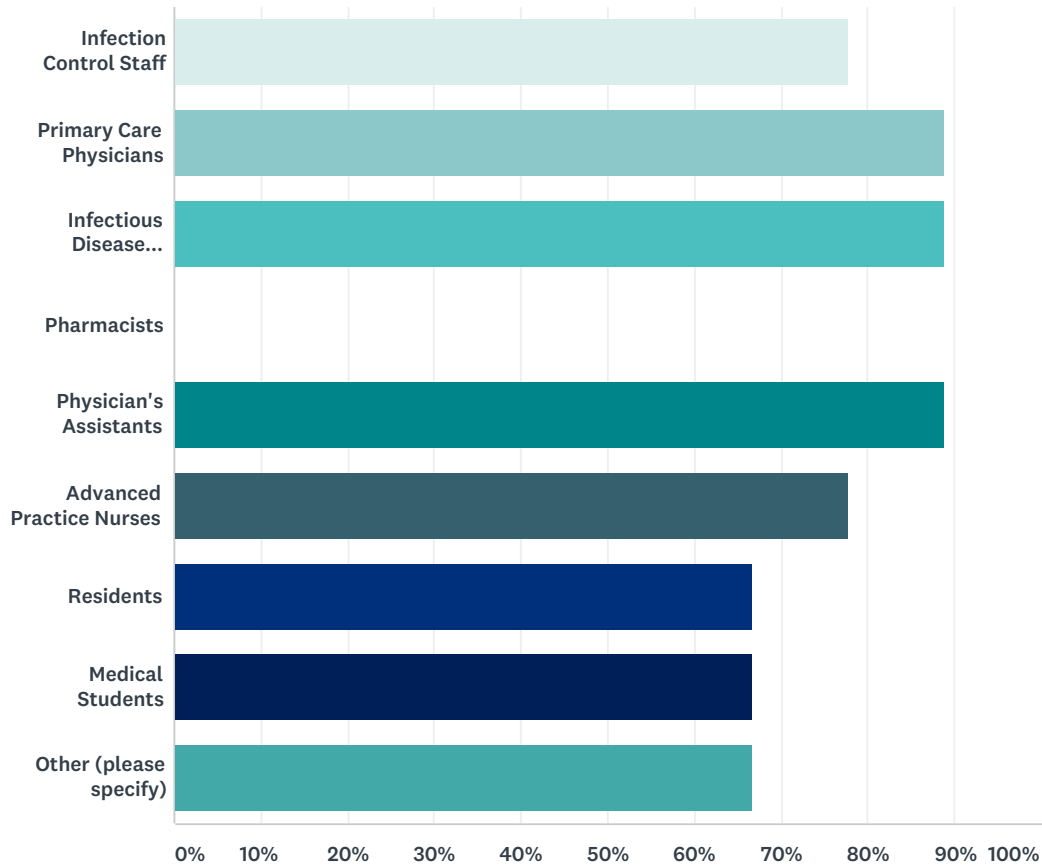

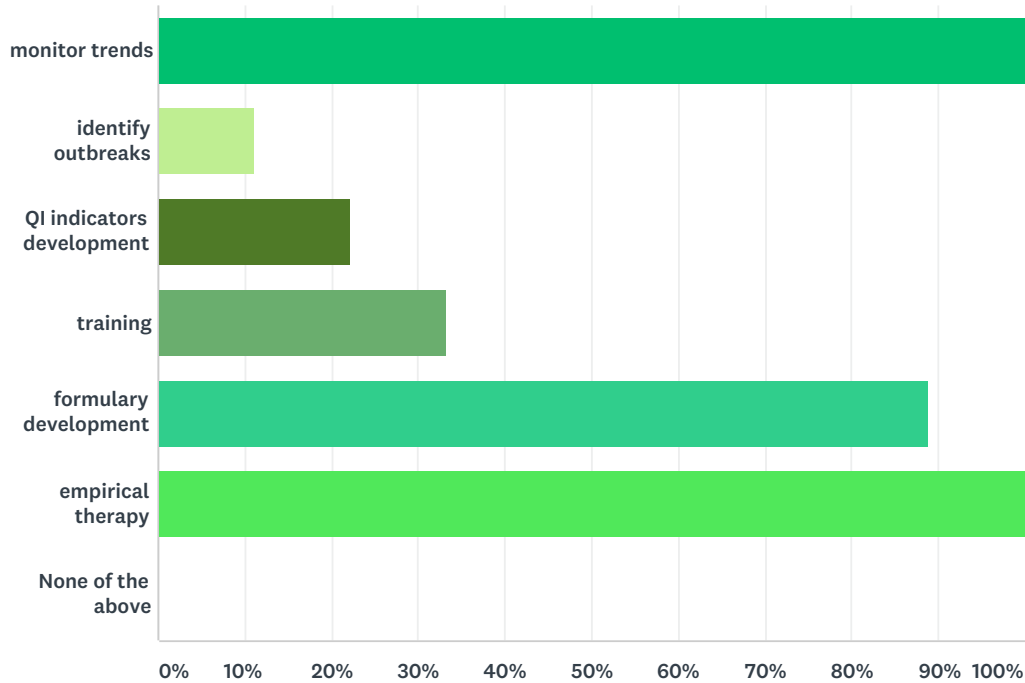

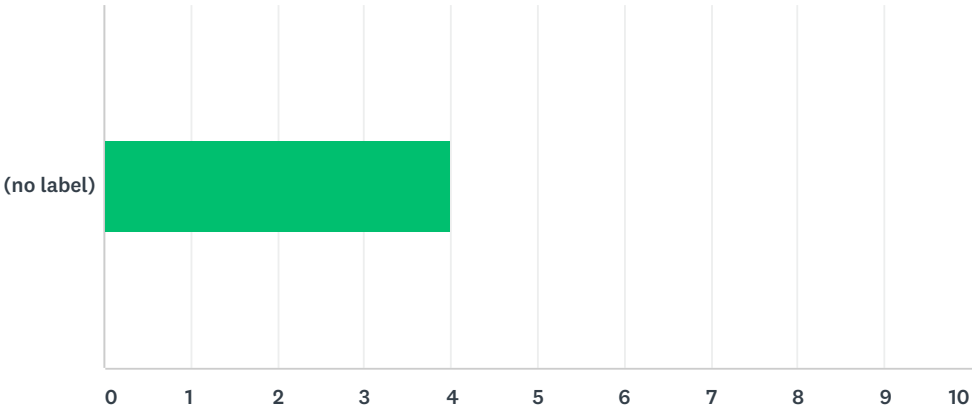

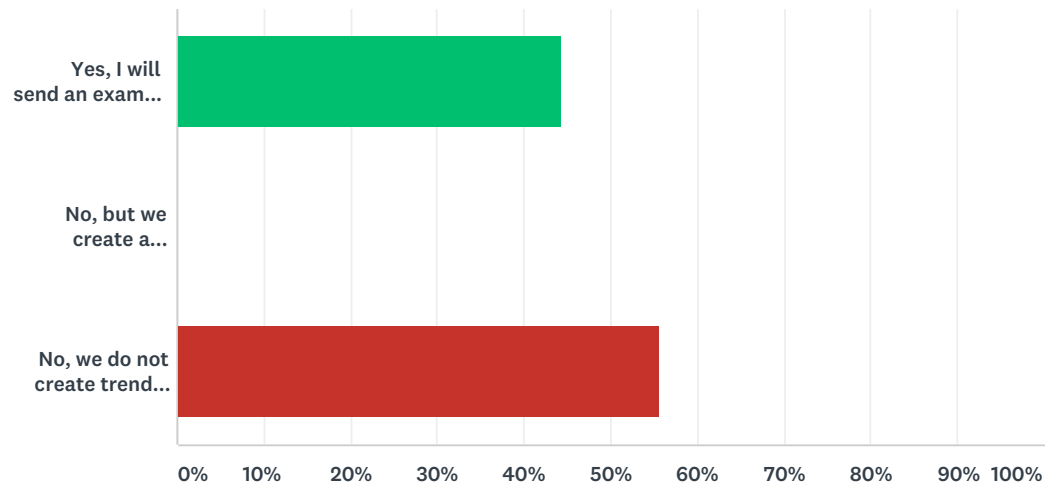

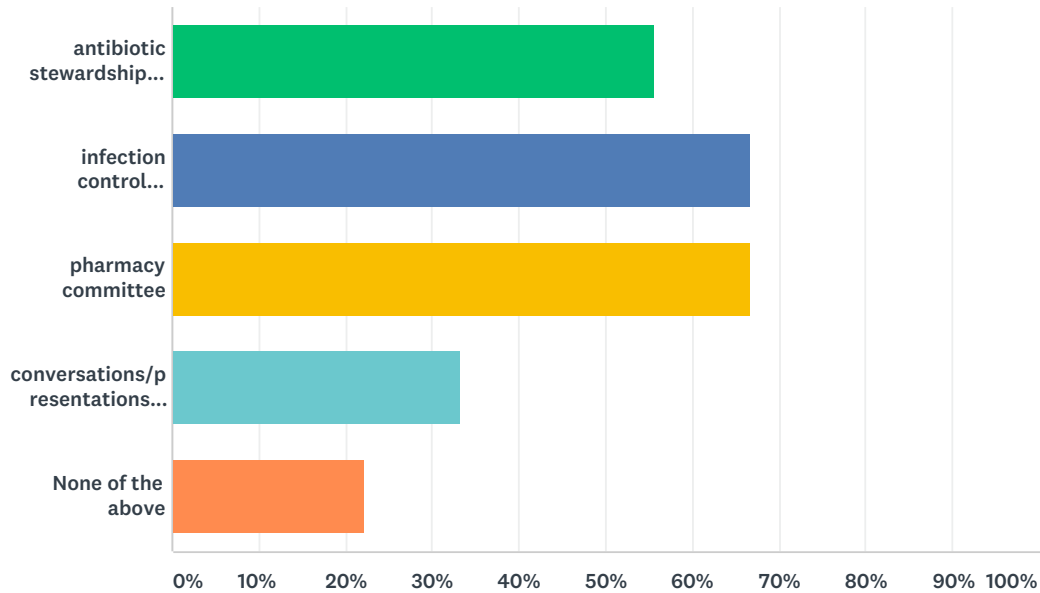
