- *(e.g. Instigated a full blown public health investigation, ruled out a rumor, prepared a communication to providers, prepared a communication to the public, developed more specific surveillance activities based on syndromic intelligence, did a detailed reach back and look into specific syndromic records, deployed or adjusted a public health intervention, etc.)*
