On Wednesday, February 3, 2021, at 9:00 PM ET, we will take the RStudio server down to install the latest version of RStudio Pro. This maintenance window is expected to be from 9:00 PM ET to 11:00 PM ET (estimated).

We will be returning it to service as soon as this upgrade is completed. (Note: RStudio Pro will be unavailable during this maintenance window.)

We will restart the server that provides RStudio Pro.
