Patient Safety Reporting Program

Despite everyone’s best intentions during healthcare, things don’t always go as planned and adverse events or near misses occur. Our Patient Safety Reporting Program (PSRP) is designed to make care safer by sharing knowledge across the state about adverse events and strategies for prevention. It is a non-punitive system to cultivate trust, inspire information sharing, and motivate quality improvement among healthcare organizations.

How it Works

Share. Learn. Improve.

Healthcare organizations voluntarily contribute information to PSRP about when, how, and why patient harm occurs, as well as their strategies for preventing it in the future. We analyze that information and share what we learn statewide so broader process and system improvements can be put into place throughout Oregon. And all contributions to PSRP are protected under state law, creating a safe environment where patient safety innovation can

Participant Benefits

By contributing information about adverse events and near misses to PSRP, healthcare organizations can:

- **Access additional expertise for decreasing events and improving quality.** PSRP is a source of confidential advice for organizations seeking to learn from their experience and design safer systems of care for the next patient.
- **Take advantage of the confidentiality protections provided by state law.** With these protections, organizations can feel comfortable in reporting robust, actionable patient safety information they are using to make care safer ([ORS 442.846](#)).
- **Be a part of a network for sharing and learning.** We share important information about adverse events statewide, on a de-identified basis, so that facilities can learn from one another.
- **Be recognized for your efforts.** Organizations meeting or exceeding PSRP recognition targets are acknowledged on our website and can display a recognition emblem, signifying their achievement, on their own website.
