OVERVIEW OF ISOLATE BANK

The Antibiotic Resistant (AR) Isolate Bank is a repository of CP-CRE isolates with known resistance profiles assembled by the CDC and FDA. The AR Bank is available to support and advance development of diagnostic devices and antimicrobial drug products.

WHY ORDER?

These isolates may be used to validate testing methods for CP-CRE identification in sentinel laboratories.

WHAT IS THE COST?
