- Level-setting
 - Discussion on the need to meet public health agencies where they are through where they could be

 - RCKMS - COVID-19 and which states are further along
 - May need to extend time for survey
 - Provide assessment by 5/6 - allow two weeks for review
- Julie
 - a. Capture
 - b. Reporting
 - i. Feasibility of reporting - eCR and ELR
 - ii. How is provider sending to the lab
 - iii. How is lab sending to public health
 - c. Lab - are you using the data? If so, which conditions are they?
 - d. Is lab is receiving the data and are they able to put it into a lab report or transmission?
 - e. How do we inform providers about the need to report? How are they being educated on how and when to make sure to report to public health? Check off box - is there a prenatal workflow for laboratory ordering?
 - i. EHR
 - ii. Lab requisition system
- Testing is being done at non-traditional locations by non-traditional providers; can it be applied when you order a lab test. Same issue exists for race/ethnicity. CARES Act requires reporting of this and it's not universally done. COVID had special federal requirements that may not be applicable for other diseases.
- Do labs have the capacity to cross check results within a lab - pregnancy test then a reportable disease test?
- May already be asked for certain conditions and not others.
- SET-NET sites - CDC team can think around who has demonstrated that work already
- People who work on maternal mortality events - pretty laborious process.
