



NEW CSTE Drug Overdose Consultant Opportunity

CSTE is currently accepting applications for those interested in a drug overdose consultant opportunity. We are seeking data abstractors to participate in on-site technical assistance with overdose surveillance teams located at state health departments throughout the country. These positions are individual short-term consultancies, where the consultant will travel to a health department and help staff abstract data from death certificates, medical examiner/coroner reports, and toxicology reports into the State Unintentional Drug Overdose Reporting System, SUDORS. During these assignments, the consultant's main responsibility will be to enter cases into SUDORS, address coding questions, and provide related data abstraction technical assistance as needed.

Previous experience working with injury surveillance systems or opioid overdose-specific projects is not required, but would be preferred. Relevant training about SUDORS and data abstraction will be provided.

These consultant opportunities may develop quickly and will generally be several days in duration. Consultants may be offered multiple opportunities to travel and assist state health departments as project needs develop. Repeated participation will help build capacity over time and increase continuity of instruction. Those who can travel on short notice and are able to participate in multiple consultant opportunities will be prioritized.
