Discussion Questions from the RCKMS Content Team

Key Objectives	Questions
Discuss approaches to: (a) identify conditions for future RCKMS content releases, (b) develop RCKMS reporting specifications, and examine feasibility of content release schedules.	- The RCKMS content team reviews SRCA data to identify potential conditions for future releases, ideally reportable in several states - Is there any input on approaches to prioritizing and selecting conditions for future releases? - Are there specific conditions that are of interest but not currently available in RCKMS? - For conditions without CSTE position statements, what is the best approach to create RCKMS reporting specifications? "Basic" Reporting Specifications: Diagnosis and lab criteria "More extensive" Reporting Specifications: Could include other types of criteria, e.g., clinical symptoms, demographic, etc. - Would states be willing to provide feedback into developing RCKMS reporting specifications for new conditions? - Does the current frequency of RCKMS Content Releases meet states' needs? - Current scheduled releases: 2 RCKMS Content Releases per year (June & January) - Emergent releases: As needed through the year - Are there any suggestions to change the frequency of RCKMS content releases?
Identify methods to receive jurisdictions' input on the current composition of the Reportable Conditions Trigger Codes (RCTC)	- Are the current RCTC meeting condition-specificity expectations? - Are there any current practices used (internally) in jurisdictions to review RCTC codes? - If so, briefly describe RCTC review processes - Would states be willing to review and provide periodic feedback on specificity of RCTC codes used in RCKMS? - What is the preferred frequency of RCTC review?
