Hi all,

Thanks for the Group 3 call yesterday. Here are the high points and next steps:

- We had our last discussion about the Scope of Practice toolkit. **If you have any other items you want to identify or materials to forward to me, please do so as soon as possible.**
- Next, we had a productive general discussion (beyond scope of practice issues) about the public health legal implications of current and recent emergency events. In the near future I will put together a summary of comments from all the groups to share with everyone about the various legal issues encountered with recent events.
- We closed by briefly reviewing the Emergency Use Authorization toolkit, which we will discuss on our next call.
