Increasing Timely Access to Available Substance Use Disorder Treatment

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What is it?

- **Dynamic near-real-time substance use disorder (SUD) treatment facility locator and information repository**
- **Valuable tool for healthcare professionals, public safety officials, and the general public**

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SUD Treatment Facility and Provider Statistics

Currently indexing 534 SUD treatment facilities

Majority of participating facilities have an AODE, BHSO or CMHC license number



Nearly 275 facilities offer Medication Assisted Treatment/ Medication for Opioid Use Disorder (MAT/MOUD) treatment

Over 100 data points captured for each facility

From **total treatment slots** to **tobacco use** and **gender-based bed assignment policies** for residential treatment



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Application in Healthcare

Enhances clinical workflow by reducing time to find available SUD treatment options

Search Results of SUD facilities with openings sorted by distance in under 20 seconds. Refined search results in under a minute.

Quickly find and share resources with patients and their loved ones

Use search filters and text searches to target search results of resources

Match unique patient needs to SUD treatment providers

Search filters by demographics, comorbidities, additional services, payment methods, etc.



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*Statistics to Date

- **Tool to supplement the identification of need for SUD Treatment**
 - **Over 130,000 total searches (39% family/friend, 37% healthcare professional, 24% individual) since launch in March 2018**
 - **Over 277,000 unique visitors**
 - **548,100 total visits**
 - **512,000 total page views**
 - **Currently expanding FindHelpNowKY platform to six additional states**



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*Statistics to Date

- Tool to identify SUD treatment capacity in Ky over time
 - 534 total facilities
 - 123 Residential facilities (includes short-term and long-term residential, family residential, inpatient, detox (medical and non-medical))
 - 490 Outpatient
 - 239 Intensive outpatient
 - 274 MAT
 - Facilities logged in about 13,000 times to view or update their profiles
