General Take-Aways/Action Items

- Administrative Preparedness
 - Is your agency prepared and capable of pushing out resources and/or providing surge capacity in a timely manner during a disaster or public health emergency response?
- Big 4 (ASTHO, NACCHO, APHL, CSTE)
 - Establish a Basecamp site (or another document sharing platform) to assist with communications and coordination among the 4 Non-Profits and CDC for future disaster and public health emergency responses
 - CSTE will develop a Basecamp site and demo on the next quarterly call with the 4 Non-Profits and CDC
 - Host “Big-4 Coordination Calls” for situational awareness during CDC EOC activations for national disaster or public health emergency responses
 - Identify non-profit liaisons for participation during CDC EOC activations
 - Broaden emergency response capabilities at the 4 Non-Profits’ National Offices
 - Participate in a concurrent non-profits’ emergency response exercise(s)
 - Invite relevant CIOs to future annual meetings
- ASTHO
 - Association-based mitigation activities to lower burden of administrative preparedness
- CSTE
 - Lead a concurrent non-profit emergency response exercise during CDC’s pan flu exercise
 - Build resources to explain how capabilities fit into all areas of public health
 - Ex. How disaster epidemiology fits into PHEP funding
- CDC
 - Coordinate quarterly call between CDC, ASTHO, NACCHO, APHL, and CSTE
