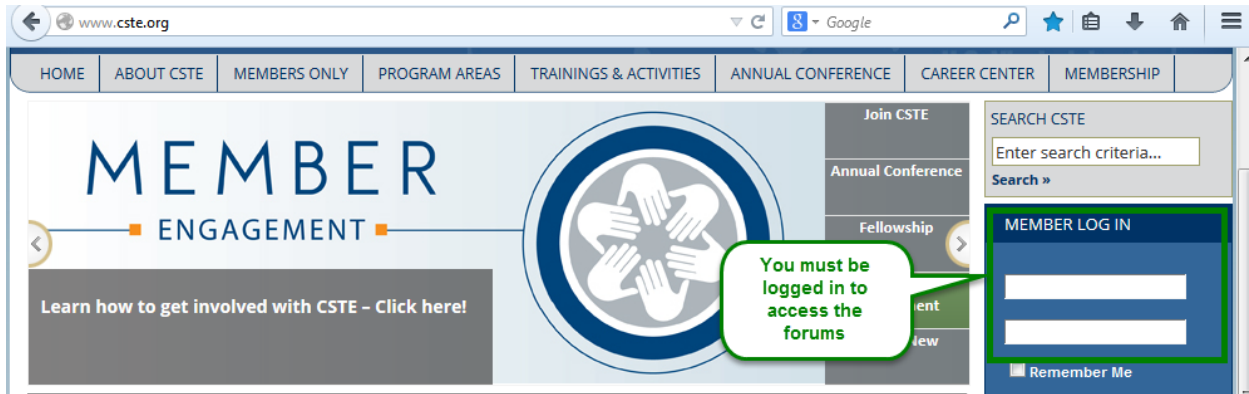


Instructions for Accessing and Using the Ebola Virus Disease (EVD) Discussion Board Forums

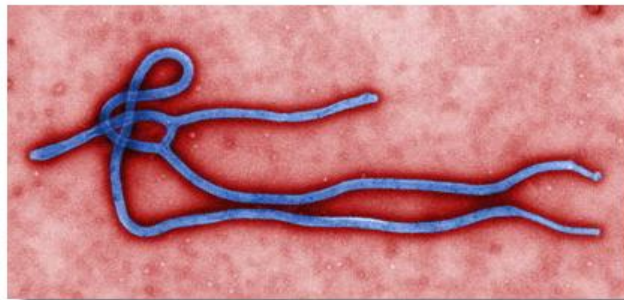
To access the Ebola Virus Disease (EVD) webpage and discussion board forums, you must be logged in to the CSTE Website (www.cste.org).
