- **Develop Operational Components of Pan Flu Annex**
- **Engage all stakeholders in planning process**
- **Coordinate information flow**
- **Exercise and evaluate effectiveness of plan By August 31, 2006**

Zoonotic Disease Response Planning

- **Information flow between animal agencies**
- **Disease responder surveillance**
- **Personal protective equipment recommendation**
- **Surge capacity to support dead bird reporting and bird testing**
- **Biomedical waste disposal**



Zurveillance and Response Partners

- **Department of Agriculture (USDA-vs)**
- **Fish and Game-(USDA-ws)**
- **Other**
 - **Environmental Protection**
 - **Mosquito Control**
 - **Animal Control**
 - **Veterinarians**

Funding

- **USDA-veterinary services**
 - **Poultry surveillance and response**
- **USDA-wildlife services**
 - **Wild bird surveillance**
- **CDC-**
 - **Human disease surveillance**
 - **Wild and pet bird testing**
 - **Education/ table top exercises**
 - **Data sharing**



Coordination at all levels

- Agency Heads
 - Public Information Officers
 - Technical Specialists
 - Field Personnel
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- Federal Partners
 - Interest organizations (NASPHV)

- **Intersecting plans**
- **Protocols for surge capacity**
- **Incident command training**
- **Information flow**
 - **Data sharing**
 - **Public information (Joint Information System)**
- **Joint trainings**

Response to first positive bird

- **Wild Bird**
 - Local incident command
 - Intensified bird and human AI surveillance
 - Risk communication
 - Animal disease responder surveillance
- **Poultry**
 - Emergency Declaration Likely
 - Joint Command
 - Medical care, Epidemiology



Policy

- Department of Health is committed to:
 - Facilitate access to vaccine and antiviral medications for animal disease responders
- Per CDC/ WHO guidelines
