Dr. Cecil Lynch is a medical informaticist and is focused on public health surveillance and the intersection of public health and clinical care. Dr. Lynch is an obstetrician gynecologist and holds an MD degree from UCLA medical school, where he also completed his residency training. Dr. Lynch also holds a MS degree in medical informatics, from the University of California at Davis. He is an Assistant Professor at UC Davis in Medical Informatics and has served in several leadership positions including Immediate past Chair of the Informatics Graduate Group and the Chief of the Office of Informatics and Surveillance for the California Department of Health Services Division of Communicable Diseases. Dr. Lynch is also the Chief Knowledge Engineer for OntoReason, LLC, a Artificial Intelligence software company providing solutions to the CDC, State of California and the pharmaceutical industry. Dr. Lynch is currently a co-chair for the HL7 Vocabulary Technical Committee and a member consultant to the European Centers for Disease Knowledge Management Workgroup. He has served on the National Cancer Institute's caBIG project as a Vocabulary and Architecture consultant for its initial 2 years. He teaches courses in Information and Knowledge Modeling and Enterprise architecture at UC Davis with a special interest in ontological modeling.
