

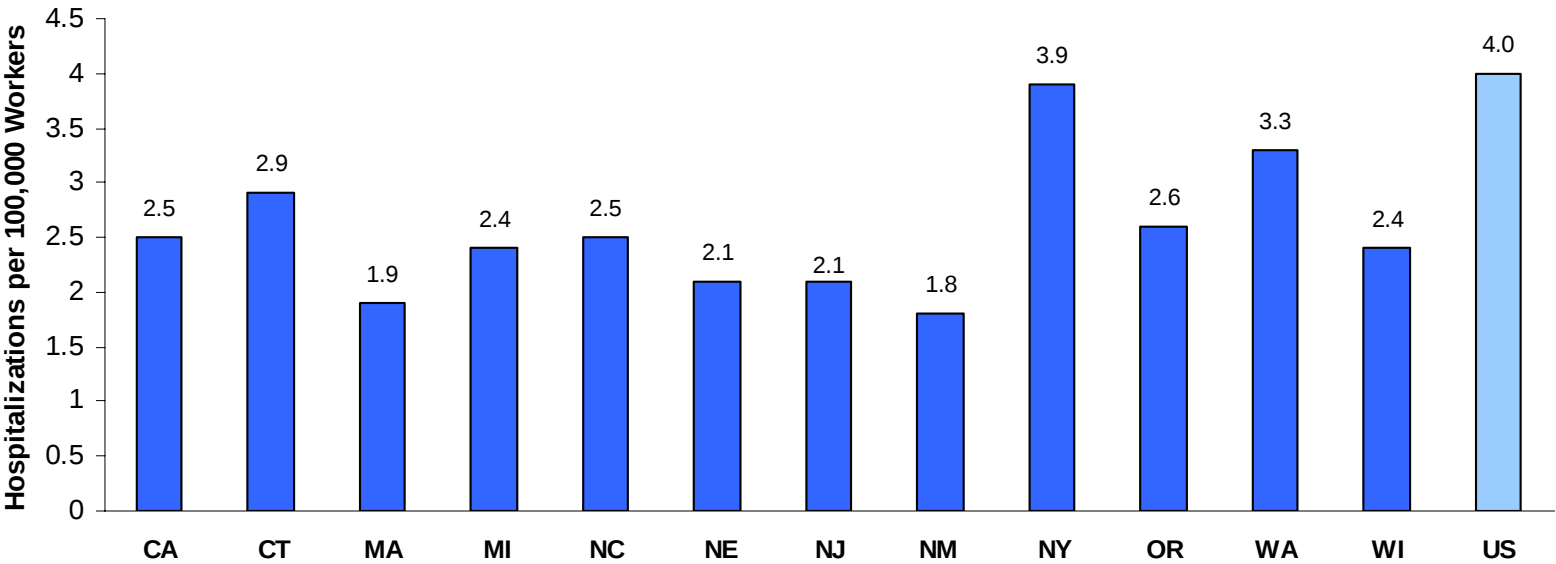

Hospital discharge records are limited to records for non-federal, acute care hospitals and are limited to state residents 16 years or older. This indicator excludes reference state residents hospitalized out of state. These exclusions will result in some undercount of cases. The degree of undercounting may vary by state.

Some workers are hospitalized more than once for the same burn injury. Due to data limitations, these secondary hospitalizations cannot be excluded. Thus, this indicator is a measure of burn hospitalizations, not burn injuries.
