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Participation Guidelines:

1. Discussion during the Sunday preconference workshop is limited to the content of the position statement only.
 - a. Discussions of notification methodology will take place on Wednesday in the Surveillance/Informatics Steering Committee session.
 - b. All new infectious position statements (including VHF, Dengue) will be discussed during the Wednesday Infectious session
2. The workshop Chair(s) will strictly adhere to the time table set for discussions to allow for fair representation of the reformatted position statements that have been identified for discussion
3. Each position statement will be discussed for **25 minutes maximum**.
 - a. After that time, discussions and modifications to the actual position statement will be moved out of the room and may continue in the Position Statement Resource Room or some other venue.
4. Position statements will be modified in the Position Statement Resource Room.
 - a. CSTE staff will be available to assist authors downloading, and uploading the correct documents to the position statement Forum.
5. Only the CSTE author, CSTE staff or designee will have the rights to make changes to position statements in the Position Statement Resource Room. Any changes will need to be routed through the CSTE author or designee.
6. Should someone suggest that a position statement be removed from the consent calendar, that position statement will be discussed after the originally identified position statements have been discussed at the end of the workshop (if time permits) **OR** at the Tuesday Infectious Diseases session.
7. Authors whose position statements have unresolved issues may propose changes to the document on Tuesday in the Infectious Diseases session.
 - a. Non-infectious diseases reformatted position statements may have further discussions in their respective steering committee position statement sessions on Wednesday.
8. Once a position statement has been recommended for the consent calendar at the workshop, any changes that are made thereafter must be documented and the position statement will be no longer on the consent calendar.
9. If an author is not in the room to present that condition when it is up for discussion, the next position statement will be presented and that position statement will be moved to the end of the line for discussions at the end of that session (AM or PM sessions).
